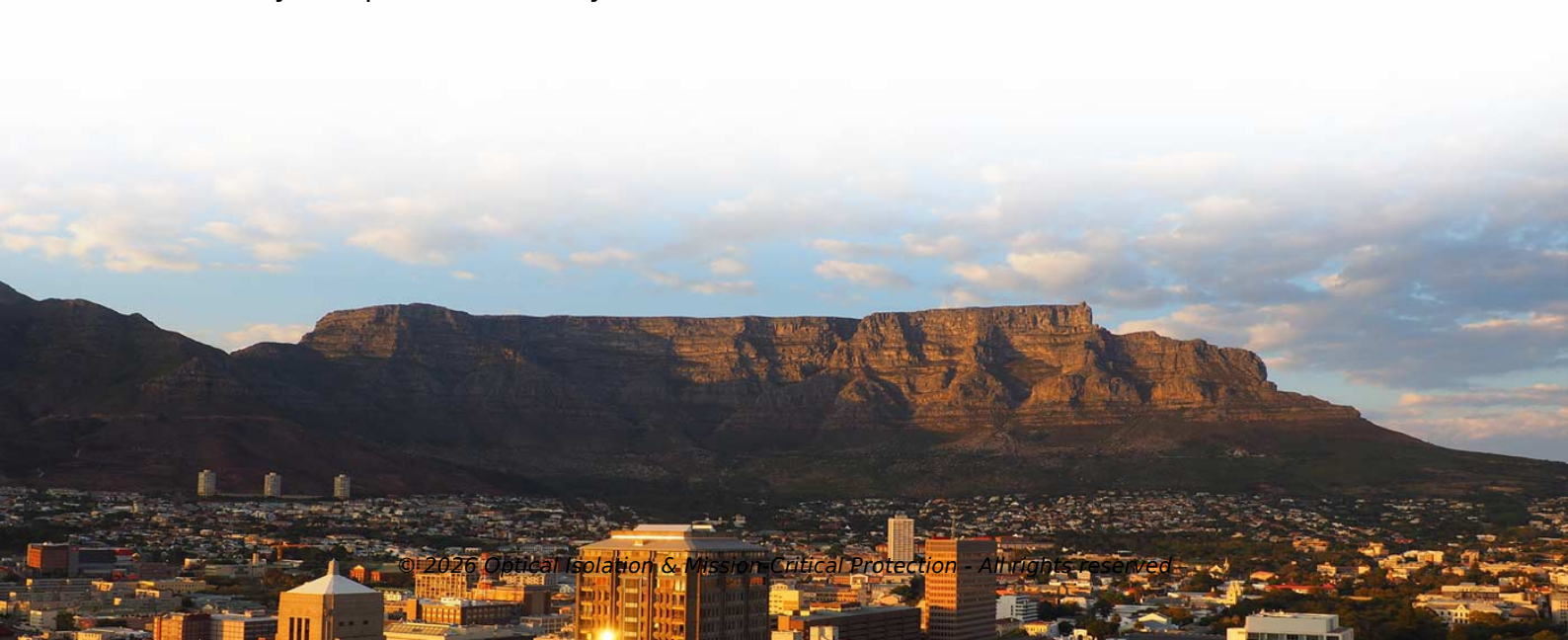


Grounding wire inside the data center AC equipment rack

Bonding (or grounding) is a system of protective measures, which is implemented to prevent electric shocks when touching metal parts of energy-powered equipment. Abstract—The indoor grounding system at a data center has been an evolving discipline from its inception in the early days where almost all data centers had a raised floor construction. The unit subs feed panelboards which feed CPCs (which have 208-208Y/120V k-factor shielded isolation transformers and 4 wire panelboards). The Mesh-BN is the backbone of the bonding system, designed to ensure a uniform electrical potential across the entire data center.
