

How much length should be reserved before the cable enters the cable tray

Your cable tray length must always be longer than or equal to the support span you have selected. The standard NEMA lengths for cable tray are 12, 20, 24 and 30-feet, although some manufacturers like Eaton offer cable tray in lengths up to 40 feet. This includes both the. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck. Bearers shall be spaced evenly along the length of the bundle. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (AJ)) in that document provides requirements for cable support. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation.
