

# How to clear alarms from industrial switches



## Overview

In such cases you can use the Deactivate Alarms utility to remove these permanently active alarms from the Alarms viewer. Do not incorrectly configure the software or the devices. Do not base your maintenance or service actions solely on messages and information displayed by. Active alarms can continue to appear in the Alarms viewer if, for example, an alarm dropout has not been configured, or a device has been removed from the network after an alarm was issued. When a device is entered into Maintenance Mode, no alerts, for that device, will be sent out for the alarm actions defined in the notification policies. DCE will still see the alarms, and record them within Alarm History, but no. Once an alarm is cleared, it remains in the database as a cleared alarm.
