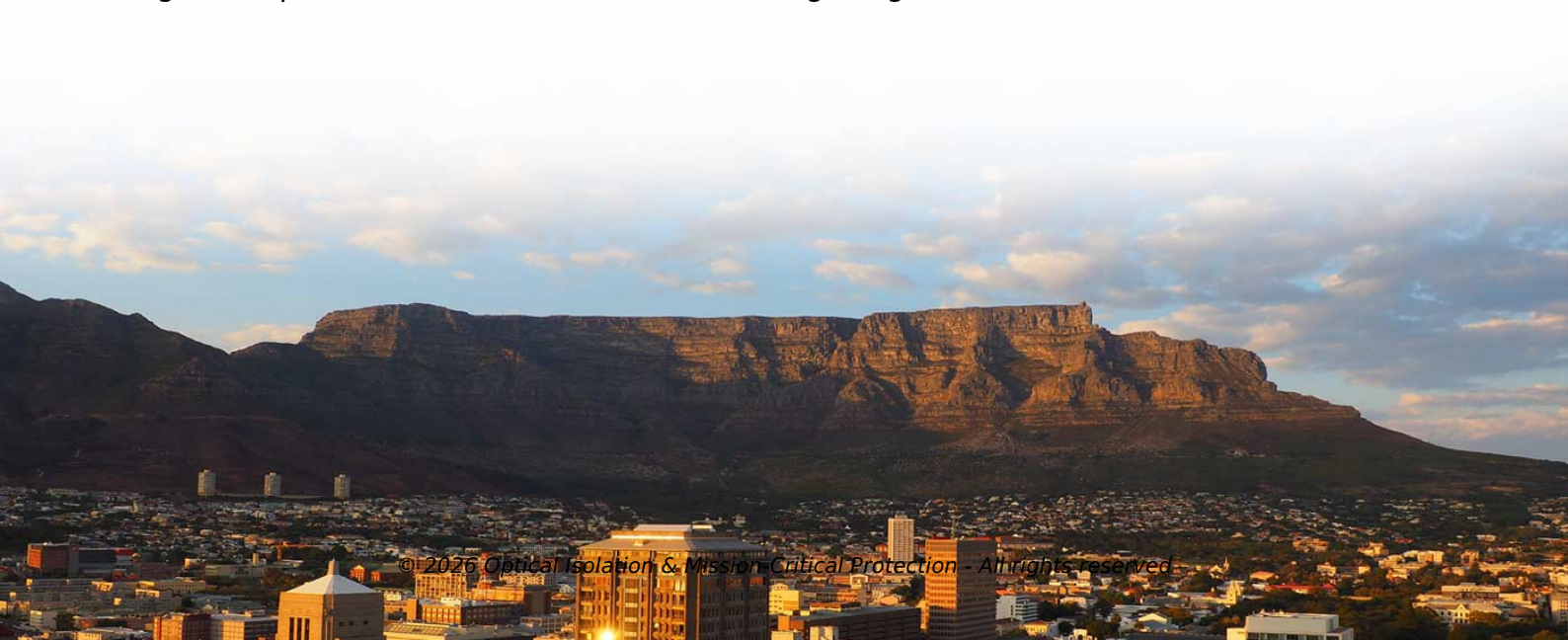


How to separate optical fibers in optical cables

Unlike active devices (which require power), splitters operate without electricity, relying solely on the physics of.
