

Sealing the openings of roof cable trays



Overview

For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing. Layout and positioning must be reasonable to facilitate installation and maintenance. Choose appropriate fire protection materials, such as fire-rated board, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or.
