Overview

Issue: Overheating can occur when the distribution board is overloaded or when there are faulty connections, which increases the risk of fire. First, the causes of distribution box fire mainly include the following four aspects: 1. Leakage fire: The so-called leakage of electricity means that the insulation ability of the wire or the bracket material decreases due to some reasons (natural or man-made reasons, such as wind and rain. When a circuit breaker trips, it releases a cocked spring mechanism that separates the electrical contacts. Circuit breakers have two means of tripping: (1) An electromagnet that trips almost instantaneously when the current is between nine (9) and 15 times the rated current of the circuit breakers. Improper installation position The installation position of the distribution box should be convenient for operation and maintenance, and should be away from humid, high temperature and flammable and explosive environments. But hazards can also exist because the electrical system of a facility or home was not installed, upgraded, or maintained properly. Solution: Identify the Cause: Check if the breaker is tripping due to overloading. finding out why the fire panel has a ground fault on the data circuit.
