In nearly all aftermarket audio installations, the remote turn-on lead uses a blue or a blue wire with a white stripe for. ⚠ Reversing these wires can drain your battery or damage electronics! • Always has power (even when car is off) • Maintains radio memory and clock • Connect to yellow wire on head unit ⚠ WARNING: Never reverse these connections! Connecting yellow to red or red to yellow will drain your battery or. Power wires are responsible for providing electrical power to the head unit. They usually come in two different colors: red, for the main power source, and yellow, for the constant power source. The power wire supplies electricity to the system, while the ground wire ensures the circuit completes its path. The first step is to determine the method used to secure the stereo, which can be done by consulting the car's repair manual or looking closely once the trim pieces have been. This involves disassembling your dashboard and running multiple wires from the head of the vehicle to the sub in the trunk or under your front seat.
